

Yet another unconfirmed rumor on the health of Chavez (translated):

"The whole truth about Hugo Chavez: Chavez is in a "coma" suffering from septicemia and is located in a home of Fidel Castro.

"The state of health of President Hugo Chavez of Venezuela has caused a million and one hypothesis. El Nuevo Herald of Miami has stated that the Bolivarian president was in critical condition after an operation for prostate cancer, news that was denied by the Venezuelan government. In the last hours, Periodista-Latino.com has learned from sources in Havana that Chavez is in a coma after an emergency operation which was performed on 10 June.

"Our source, who prefers to remain anonymous, claims that the president is located in one of the residences of Fidel Castro, which is equipped with the latest medical technology and monitored by a medical team, including arrivals from several European countries. Security is very strict. Hugo Chavez has not been admitted to a hospital as the Venezuelan government has claimed because the information leaks could be devastating.

"According to the official, he was operated on for a pelvic abscess last June 10 in Havana. After the operation, we were told, he became infected and had to be put on 'purification equipment', but the pus would have complicated the kidneys, pancreas and liver. Five days ago Chavez went into a coma."

"Venezuela's Comptroller General dies in Cuba

"The Comptroller General of Venezuela, Russian Clodobaldo Uzcategui, one of the key men closest to President Hugo Chavez, died last week in Cuba. Note that a few days after the death of Russian, Chavez went into a coma.

"Russian suffered stroke on April 22, when he enjoyed a few days off in the resort of Rio Chico, east of Caracas. After being admitted to a clinic in Caracas, he was referred to a Cuban hospital 'where he received medical treatment until his death.' His death was announced via Twitter.

"If Chavez could talk, given his character, he would have talked some time ago. Chavez has a condition called septicemia (a blood infection caused by the uncontrollable multiplication of bacteria)."
